AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 298

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 9, after “circumstances;” insert “requiring a county superintendent or the superintendent’s representative to notify the principal of a school of the arrest for a certain offense of a student enrolled in the school; requiring the principal to notify certain teachers of the student’s arrest;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, after line 40, insert:

“(F) (1) UPON NOTIFICATION FROM THE STATE’S ATTORNEY THAT A STUDENT HAS BEEN ARRESTED FOR A REPORTABLE OFFENSE, AS DEFINED BY § 7-302.1(A)(5) OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OR THE SUPERINTENDENT’S DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL NOTIFY THE PRINCIPAL OF THE SCHOOL IN WHICH THE STUDENT IS ENROLLED OF THE STUDENT’S ARREST.

(2) THE PRINCIPAL SHALL NOTIFY ANY TEACHER WHO HAS SUBSTANTIAL CONTACT WITH THE STUDENT OF THE STUDENT’S ARREST.”.

On page 5, in lines 1 and 30, strike “(f)” and “(G)”, respectively, and substitute “(G)” and “(H)”, respectively.
