AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1129

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “persons” in line 5 and substitute “prohibiting certain pharmacies from refusing to contract with or participate in the State employee prescription drug benefit plan under certain circumstances; providing for the effective date of this Act”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 12 through 14, inclusive, and substitute:

“(9) MAY NOT REFUSE TO CONTRACT WITH OR PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE EMPLOYEE PRESCRIPTION DRUG BENEFIT PLAN ON THE BASIS OF REIMBURSEMENT LEVEL IF THE REIMBURSEMENT LEVEL OFFERED IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO THE REIMBURSEMENT LEVEL THE PHARMACY ACCEPTS FROM OTHER PLANS, PROGRAMS, OR ARRANGEMENTS IN THE STATE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 22, strike “October” and substitute “June”.
