[TAG actc]AN ACT concerning Bail Bonds - Searchers for Fugitive Defendants - Qualifications

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person who has been convicted of a felony from engaging in the business of securing the arrest, apprehension, or surrender of a defendant who violates a condition of a bail bond; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to persons who search for defendants who fail to comply with the terms of their bail bonds.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

Annotated Code of Maryland  
(1992 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments**

(f) (1) (I) The circuit courts for each of the counties are authorized to prescribe by rule of court the terms and conditions of bail bonds filed in the circuit court for each county respectively.

(II) [This] SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THIS power includes but is not limited to prescribing the qualifications of and fees charged by bondsmen.

(III) A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF A FELONY MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF SECURING THE ARREST, APPREHENSION, OR SURRENDER OF A DEFENDANT WHO VIOLATES A CONDITION OF A BAIL BOND.

(IV) A bond commissioner may be appointed to administer the rules of

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court adopted pursuant to this section.

(V) Violations of any rule of court promulgated hereunder shall be considered contempt of court and punished as for contempt.

(VI) In addition a person may not engage in the business of becoming surety for compensation on bonds in criminal cases until [he shall have been]THE PERSON IS approved by such rules as the circuit court may have adopted and, if required under the provisions of Article 48A of the Code, licensed in accordance with Article 48A of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
