- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - Education

- 20 [(g) In Montgomery County, the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community
- 21 College may:
- 22 (1) Provide in its bid specifications that a product grown, mined, or
- 23 manufactured in the Republic of South Africa may be rejected; and
- 24 (2) Reject a bid for a product grown, mined, or manufactured in the
- 25 Republic of South Africa.]

- 27 (a) In this subtitle, the following words have the meanings indicated.

1 (b) "El	igible	institu	tion"	means:

- 2 (1) Each public sector higher education institution identified in §§ 10-101(j) 3 and 12-101(4) of this article or its affiliated foundation; and
- 4 (2) Each community college which receives State funding under Title 16,
- 5 Subtitle 4 of this article or its affiliated foundation.
- 6 (c) (1) "Eligible private donor" means any individual, corporation, partnership,
- $7\ \ \text{or other form of business organization, public or private foundation, or other nonprofit}$
- 8 organization.
- 9 (2) "Eligible private donor" does not include the State, any subdivision of 10 the State, the federal government, or any foreign government.
- 11 (d) [(1)] "Eligible program" means any endowment for an academic purpose,
- 12 which does not contain unreasonable restrictions as to use as further defined by the
- 13 Maryland Higher Education Commission.
- 14 [(2) "Eligible program" does not include any endowment that is invested in
- 15 whole or in part in any stock, security, or other obligation of any company doing business
- 16 in or with the Republic of South Africa.]
- 17 (e) "Endowment" means any donation or gift which has been provided under the
- 18 condition that the principal remain intact and be invested in perpetuity for the purpose of
- 19 producing income.
- 20 (f) "Base year" means July 1, 1988 through June 30, 1989.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 July 1, 1996.
