18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (c) (1) An original or substitute commemorative plate may only be issued under
4 this section for a fixed period of 2 consecutive years after its initial issuance.

5 (2) The Administration may only issue 1 commemorative plate under this
6 section at any one time.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the
10 provisions of § 13-618(c) of the Transportation Article, the Motor Vehicle
11 Administration shall [extend] CONTINUE the Chesapeake Bay Commemorative Plate
12 Program until [July 1, 1996] ~~LEGISLATION TO TERMINATE THE PROGRAM IS~~

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
