- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Education
- 21 5-105.
- 22 (a) This section does not apply to Baltimore City.
- 23 (b) All revenues received by a county board shall be spent by the board in
- 24 accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under § 5-101 of
- 25 this subtitle.
- 26 (c) (1) A transfer may be made within the major categories without recourse to
- 27 the county commissioners or county council except that a report of the transfer shall be
- 28 submitted to the county commissioners or county council at the end of each month.

1	(2) A transfer between major categories shall be made only withthe
2	approval of the county commissioners or county council.
3	(3) If the county commissioners or county council fail to take action on a
4	request for transfer between major categories within 30 days after the receipt of a written
5	request substantiating the transfer, the failure to take action constitutes approval.
6	(d) Nonlocal funds received by a county board after the adoption of the annual
7	budget by the county fiscal authority may be spent by the county board if the county fiscal
8	authority is notified and approves of:
9	(1) The source and amount of the funds; and

- 10 (2) The manner of spending the funds.

- 12 EACH QUARTER, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
- 13 ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY COUNCIL A REPORT DETAILING ALL EXPENDITURES
- 14 WITHIN THE MAJOR CATEGORIES OF ITS ANNUAL BUDGET.
- 15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16 October 1, 1996.
