BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Education** 20

(a) This section does not apply to Baltimore City.

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- (b) All revenues received by a county board shall be spent by the board in 2 accordance with the major categories of its annual budget as provided under § 5-101 of 3 this subtitle. 4 (c) (1) A transfer may be made within the major categories without recourse to 5 the county commissioners or county council except that a report of the transfer shall be 6 submitted to the county commissioners or county council at the end of each month. 7 (2) A transfer between major categories shall be made only withthe 8 approval of the county commissioners or county council. 9 (3) If the county commissioners or county council fail to take action on a 10 request for transfer between major categories within 30 days after the receipt of a written 11 request substantiating the transfer, the failure to take action constitutes approval. 12 (d) Nonlocal funds received by a county board after the adoption of the annual 13 budget by the county fiscal authority may be spent by the county board if the county fiscal 14 authority is notified and approves of: 15 (1) The source and amount of the funds; and 16 (2) The manner of spending the funds. 17 5-105.1. 18 EACH QUARTER ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1 AND MARCH 1 OF EACH FISCAL 19 YEAR, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD SHALL SUBMIT TO THE ANNE ARUNDEL 20 COUNTY COUNCIL A REPORT DETAILING ALL EXPENDITURES WITHIN THE MAJOR 21 CATEGORIES OF ITS ANNUAL BUDGET. THE REPORT ALSO SHALL DETAIL ANY 22 ACTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD THAT WOULD COMMIT THE COUNTY BOARD TO 23 SPEND MORE IN ANY MAJOR CATEGORY IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE 24 <u>CURRENT FISCAL YEAR THAN THE AMOUNT APPROVED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET</u>
