- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that an order awarding child support remain in effect until
- the child marries or attains a certain age; establishing a certain exception for an 4

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (D) AN ORDER AWARDING CHILD SUPPORT SHALL CONTINUE TO BE IN
- 18 EFFECT UNTIL THE FIRST TO OCCUR OF THE FOLLOWING EVENTS:
- 19 (1) THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT MARRIES; OR
- (2) THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT ATTAINS THE AGE OF 18 20
- 21 YEARS.

- 22 (E) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, AN ORDER
- 23 AWARDING CHILD SUPPORT TO AN UNMARRIED CHILD WHO IS ENROLLED IN AT
- 24 LEAST FOUR UNITS OF CREDIT IN AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR AN APPROVED
- 25 VOCATIONAL, TECHNICAL, OR POSTSECONDARY SCHOOL AS DEFINED BY THE
- 26 STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS, SHALL CONTINUE TO BE IN EFFECT UNTIL

 - (1) THE CHILD RECEIVING THE SUPPORT MARRIES; OR

- 5 (F) THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PREVENT A COURT FROM
