## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the State Lottery Agency to distribute a certain percentage of lottery proceeds to all the public school systems in the State; requiring that public school systems use the money that is distributed only for certain purposes; specifying that the money distributed under this Act is intended to provide additional revenue for public school systems and may not supplant any other appropriation to public school systems; defining a term; and generally relating to the distribution of lottery proceeds to public school systems in theState.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
1 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 COLLECTION OF PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SCHOOLS
6 UNDER THE CONTROL OF A COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION OR THE BOARD OF SCHOOL COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.
(2) Promptly after the 1st day of each month, the Comptroller shall pay: 0 COMMISSIONERS OF BALTIMORE CITY.
(B) THE SHARE OF PROCEEDS TO WHICH AN INDIVIDUAL PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IS ENTITLED UNDER THE DISTRIBUTION REQUIREMENT UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL BE PROPORTIONATE TO THE AMOUNT OF SALES OF LOTTERY TICKETS MADE IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE SCHOOL SYSTEM IS LOCATED.
(C) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL USE THE MONEY DISTRIBUTED UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE ONLY FOR:
(1) CLASSROOM AIDES AND STUDENT SUPPORT STAFF; OR
(2) INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.
(D) A DISTRIBUTION UNDER § 9-120(B)(1)(II) OF THIS SUBTITLE IS INTENDED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL REVENUE FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS AND MAY NOT SUPPLANT ANY OTHER DISTRIBUTION OF LOTTERY PROCEEDS TO PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 1996.
