- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 15 Article 49B Human Relations Commission
- 16 12A.
- 17 It is unlawful for any person to aid, abet, incite, compel, or coerce or to attempt,
- 18 directly or indirectly, alone or in concert with others, to commit any act declared by this
- 19 article to be an unlawful practice; [or] to obstruct or prevent any person from complying
- 20 with the provisions of or any order issued pursuant to this article; ORTO RETALIATE
- 21 AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS MADE A CHARGE, TESTIFIED, ASSISTED, OR
- 22 PARTICIPATED IN ANY MANNER IN AN INVESTIGATION, PROCEEDING, OR HEARING
- 23 UNDER THIS ARTICLE.
- 24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall take effect
