4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from retaliating against an individual who
5 makes a charge, testifies, assists, or participates in an investigation, proceeding, or
6 hearing under the Human Relations Commission law; and generally relating to
7 aiding or abetting violation of the Human Relations Commission law.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 49B - Human Relations Commission**

16 12A.

17 It is unlawful for any person to aid, abet, incite, compel, or coerce or to attempt,
18 directly or indirectly, alone or in concert with others, to commit any act declared by this
19 article to be an unlawful practice; [or] to obstruct or prevent any person from complying
20 with the provisions of or any order issued pursuant to this article; OR TO RETALIATE
21 AGAINST AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS MADE A CHARGE, TESTIFIED, ASSISTED, OR

1 PARTICIPATED IN ANY MANNER IN AN INVESTIGATION, PROCEEDING, OR HEARING

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
