- (b) Any person who (1) intentionally mutilates or cruelly kills an animal, or
- 15 causes, procures, or authorizes the cruel killing or intentional mutilation of an animal;
- 16 [or] (2) uses or permits a dog to be used in A DOGFIGHT; or (3) arranges [or], conducts,
- 17 OR ATTENDS a dogfight, is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not exceeding
- 18 \$5,000 or by imprisonment not to exceed 3 years, or both.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 20 October 1, 1996.
