### 2 Vehicle Laws - Special Registration Plates - Truck Eligibility

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum manufacturer's rated capacity of a Class E

- 4 (truck) vehicle that is eligible for special personalized registration plates, amateur
- 5 radio operator's registration plates, commemorative registration plates, nonprofit
- 6 organization registration plates, or registration plates for recipients of certain
- 7 combat-related armed forces medals; and generally relating to the eligibility of
- 8 trucks for certain special registration plates.

(c) (1) A special registration number assigned under this section may consist of 18 19 any combination of not more than 7 letters and numerals. 20 (2) In its discretion, the Administration may refuse any combination of 21 letters and numerals. 22 13-617. 23 (a) (1) The owner of any vehicle described in paragraph (2) of this subsection 24 may apply to the Administration for the assignment to that vehicle of aspecial amateur 25 radio registration number, if the applicant holds an amateur radio station license issued 26 by the Federal Communications Commission. 27 (2) This section applies only as to: 28 (i) A Class A (passenger) vehicle; or 29 (ii) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a [3/4] ONE ton or less 30 manufacturer's rated capacity.

(b) Special registration may be issued and continued under this section only if the
applicant submits, with the original and each renewal application, proof satisfactory to
the Administration that the applicant holds an amateur radio station license issued by the
Federal Communications Commission.

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1 (c) In addition to the annual registration fee otherwise required by this title, the 2 applicant shall pay an additional annual fee of \$5, payable with the original and each 3 renewal application for special registration under this section. 4 (d) A special registration number assigned under this section shall consist of the 5 amateur radio call letters assigned to the applicant by the Federal Communications 6 Commission. 7 13-618. 8 (a) The Administration may issue special commemorative original or substitute 9 registration plates for any geographical, historical, natural resource, or environmental 10 commemoration of statewide significance. 11 (b) The owner of a vehicle, or a lessee of the vehicle under a leasenot intended as 12 security, or a director, officer, employee, or partner of a business entity that owns the 13 vehicle considered eligible by the Administration may apply to the Administration for the 14 assignment of a commemorative registration plate under this section if the vehicle is 15 included in one of the following classes: 16 (1) A Class A (passenger) vehicle; 17 (2) A Class B (for hire) vehicle; 18 (3) A Class E (truck) vehicle with a manufacturer's rated capacity of [3/4] 19 ONE ton or less; 20 (4) A Class G (trailer) vehicle; or 21 (5) A Class M (multipurpose) vehicle.
