- 27 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 28 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 2-2-3 of Article 11 Frederick County of theCode of
- 29 Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
- 31 read as follows:

(a) Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, in this article the following 4 words have the meanings indicated. (b) "County" means a county of the State and Baltimore City. 6 1-108. (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 8 INDICATED. (2) "PREFERENCE" INCLUDES: (I) A PERCENTAGE PREFERENCE;

(II) AN EMPLOYEE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT; OR 11

(III) ANY OTHER PROVISION THAT FAVORS A RESIDENT OVER A 12 13 NONRESIDENT.

(3) "RESIDENT BIDDER" MEANS A BIDDER WHOSE PRINCIPAL OFFICE IS 14 15 LOCATED IN THE STATE.

16 (4) "NONRESIDENT BIDDER" MEANS A BIDDER WHOSE PRINCIPAL 17 OFFICE IS LOCATED OUTSIDE THE STATE.

(B) WHEN A COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION USES COMPETITIVE 18 19 SEALED BIDDING TO AWARD A PROCUREMENT CONTRACT, IN DETERMINING THE 20 LOWEST RESPONSIVE BID, THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION:

(1) MAY NOT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST A RESIDENT BIDDER BY 21 22 GRANTING A PREFERENCE TO ANY OTHER RESIDENT BIDDER: AND

23 (2) MAY DISCRIMINATE AGAINST A NONRESIDENT BIDDER BY 24 GRANTING A PREFERENCE TO A RESIDENT BIDDER.

25 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 1996.
