## A BILL ENTITLED

3 FOR the purpose of altering language relating to modified work schedules for certain

- 4 employees of the Department of State Police to conform with the federal Fair
- 5 Labor Standards Act; and generally relating to modified work schedules of the State

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OFMARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article 88B - Department of State Police

15 23B.

(a) In this section, "nonexempt" means being entitled to pay for overtime workunder the federal Fair Labor Standards Act.

(b) If authorized by the Secretary, a law-enforcement employee or a 40-hour
civilian employee of the Department shall work an alternative [10 hour]HOURLY
workday in lieu of an 8 hour workday.

(c) Participants in the alternative modified workday program are entitled tocompensation in accordance with § 6-305 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.

23 Personal leave for these employees shall be based on an 8-hour workday.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 25 July 1, 1996.
