3 FOR the purpose of altering language relating to modified work schedules for certain
4 employees of the Department of State Police ~~to conform with the federal Fair~~
5 ~~Labor Standards Act~~; and generally relating to modified work schedules and
6 alternative workdays of the State Police.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 88B - Department of State Police**

15 23B.

16 (a) In this section, "nonexempt" means being entitled to pay for overtime work
17 under the federal Fair Labor Standards Act.

18 (b) If authorized by the Secretary, a law-enforcement employee or a 40-hour
19 civilian employee of the Department shall work an alternative [10 hour]~~HOURLY~~
20 workday OF NOT MORE THAN 12 HOURS in lieu of an 8 hour workday.

21 (c) Participants in the alternative modified workday program are entitled to
22 compensation in accordance with § 6-305 of the State Personnel and Pensions Article.
23 Personal leave for these employees shall be based on an 8-hour workday.
