1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Insurance - Fees - Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a certain fee for obtaining copies of documents on file in
4 the office of the Insurance Commissioner; providing for the future codification of
5 this Act; and generally relating to fees charged by the Insurance Commissioner
6 under the Insurance Code.

2 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
3 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

4 **Article 48A - Insurance Code**

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland
11 read as follows:

14 (a) Fees for the following certificates, licenses, and services shall be collected in
15 advance by the Commissioner, and shall be paid by the appropriate persons to the
16 Commissioner:

19 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 41(17), (18),
20 (19), (20), and (21), respectively, of Article 48A - Insurance Code of the Annotated Code
21 of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 41(16), (17), (18), (19), and (20),
22 respectively.

23 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2-112(a)(17),
24 (18), and (19), respectively, of Article - Insurance of the Annotated Code of Maryland
25 (as enacted by Chapter 36 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1995) be renumbered
26 to be Section(s) 2-112(a)(16), (17), and (18), respectively.

27 SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 1 and 3 of this
28 Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.

29 SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 2 and 4 of this
30 Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
