- 16 (a) A person may not furnish or put in use for revenue billing purposes any gas
- 17 meter or any electric meter unless it has been authorized by the Commission. Every gas
- 18 and electric company shall maintain in an appropriate place a suitable apparatus,
- 19 approved[, and stamped or marked] by the Commission, for testing the accuracy of gas
- 20 and electric meters furnished by it for use. On the written request of any consumer, his
- 21 meter shall be tested thereby, in his presence if he desires.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 23 October 1, 1996.
