14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(b) If a petition for guardianship is filed after a juvenile proceeding in which thechild has been adjudicated to be a child in need of assistance, the petitioner shall givenotice to the child's natural parent by serving a show cause order by certified mail or

- (1) if the natural parent was present at a CINA hearing and notified by thecourt of the requirements of § 3-837 of the Courts Article:
- 24 (i) at the latest address listed in juvenile court recordsmaintained in25 accordance with § 3-837 of the Courts Article;
- 26 (ii) at the latest address listed in the records of the local department of 27 social services; [or]
- (iii) at any other address listed in the records of the juvenile court orlocal department of social services within 6 months before the filing of the guardianship
- 30 petition; or

(IV) AT ANY OTHER ADDRESS FOR THE NATURAL PARENT
IDENTIFIED AFTER REASONABLE GOOD FAITH EFFORTS TO LOCATE THE PARENT;
OR

4 (2) if the natural parent was not present at a CINA hearing and notified by 5 the court of the requirements of § 3-837 of the Courts Article:

6 (i) at the latest address, if any, listed in juvenile court records 7 maintained in accordance with § 3-837 of the Courts Article; or

8 (ii) at any other address for the natural parent identified after 9 reasonable good faith efforts to locate the parent.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 1996.
