- The Administration shall refuse to issue a certificate of title of avehicle if:
- 18 (1) The application contains [any] A false or fraudulent statement;
- 19 (2) The applicant has failed to furnish information or documents required
- 20 by statute or regulations adopted by the Administration;
- 21 (3) [Any] A required fee has not been paid;
- 22 (4) The applicant is not entitled to a certificate of title under the Maryland
- 23 Vehicle Law; or
- 24 (5) The Administration has [reasonable grounds to believe] SPECIFIC
- 25 INFORMATION OR DOCUMENTS INDICATING THAT THE:
- 26 (i) [That the applicant] APPLICANT is not the owner of thevehicle;
- 27 (ii) [That the issuance] ISSUANCE of a certificate of title to the
- 28 applicant would be a fraud against another person; or
