 FOR the purpose of repealing certain provisions of law relating to the identification of physicians as specialists in fields of medical practice by the StateBoard of Physician Quality Assurance.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:	
13 Article - Health Occupations	
14 [14-604.	
15 (a) A physician may not represent to the public that the physician is a specialist in 16 any field of specialized medical practice unless identified as a specialist in that field by 17 the Board.	
18 (b) If a physician requests, the Board shall determine whether the physician 19 qualifies for Board identification as a specialist.	
20 (c) (1) The Board shall adopt rules and regulations concerning application 21 procedures, fees, and required qualifications for identification as a specialist.	
22 (2) The qualifications required of applicants for Board identification as a 23 specialist may include:	
24 (i) The requirements established by the American Board of Medical 25 Specialties, the Council of Medical Specialty Societies, and the Accreditation Council for 26 Graduate Medical Education;	
27 (ii) Education;	

(iii) Professional experience; and

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1 2	(iv) Whether, before July 1, 1984, the applicant represented to the public, in an ethical manner, that the applicant was a specialist.
3	(3) The Board may contract with the Faculty or any other nonprofit agency to process applications for identification as a specialist.

- 5 (d) In approving additional specialties, the Board may consider those fields
- 6 recognized and approved by the American Board of Medical Specialties, the Council of
- 7 Medical Specialty Societies, and the Accreditation Council for GraduateMedical
- 8 Education.]
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 1996.
