## 2 Crimes - Unlawful Taking of a Motor Vehicle - Penalty

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the penalty for knowingly and willfully taking a motor
- 4 vehicle out of the lawful custody, control, or use of the owner without the owner's

- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 14 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 16 (a) In this section, "owner" means any person who has a lawful interest in or is in
- 17 lawful possession of a motor vehicle by consent or chain of consent of the actual title
- 18 owner.
- 19 (b) A person, or the person's aiders or abettors, may not knowingly and willfully
- 20 take a motor vehicle out of the lawful custody, control, or use of the owner without the
- 21 owner's consent.
- 22 (c) A person who violates this section shall restore the motor vehicle so taken and
- 23 carried away, or, if unable to do so, shall pay to the owner the full value of the motor
- 24 vehicle.
- 25 (d) A person who violates this section is guilty of the felony of taking a motor
- 26 vehicle and on conviction is subject to a fine of not more than \$5,000 or imprisonment for
- 27 not more than [5] 15 years or both.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 1996.
