## 2 Vehicle Laws - Commemorative Registration Plates - Education

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue special
commemorative registration plates for an educational commemoration of statewide significance; increasing the number of commemorative registration plates that the Administration may issue at any one time; authorizing the Administration to disburse surplus funds received from the sale of commemorative registration plates to a local governmental entity closely related to the theme that theregistration plates commemorate; requiring the Administration, before designatinga local governmental entity to receive surplus funds from the sale of a commemorative registration plate, to adopt regulations identifying the local governmental entity and its relation to the theme commemorated by the registration plate; clarifying language; and generally relating to commemorative registration plates.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

(e) (1) The Administration shall adopt regulations not inconsistent with the 36 Maryland Vehicle Law to govern the issuance of special registration plates under this 37 section.
(i) The name and nature of the nonprofit organization OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY receiving the money;
(ii) The relationship of the nonprofit organization OR LOCAL

9 GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY to the geographical, historical, EDUCATIONAL, natural 0 resource, or environmental theme which the plate commemorates; and
(iii) The plan of distribution of the funds.
(f) The additional fee to the annual registration fee required by this section is not 3 required for special registration of a vehicle that is exempt under § 13-903 of this title, or 4 a vehicle with a special registration plate recognizing:
(1) The Maryland National Guard; or
(2) A volunteer fire department, volunteer rescue squad, or volunteer 17 ambulance company in this State.

18 (g) (1) A special registration number as specified by the Administration and 19 assigned under this section may consist of:
(2) A special registration number or design assigned under thissection shall be displayed on the registration plates for the vehicle.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1996.
