A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Unemployment Insurance - Contribution and Employment Reports**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the penalty for an employing unit that fails to submit
4 certain contribution and employment reports; and generally relating to contribution
5 and employment reports under the Unemployment Insurance Law.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Labor and Employment**

14 8-626.

15 (a) For each calendar quarter, each employing unit shall submit to the Secretary
16 a contribution and employment report on or before the date that the Secretary sets.

17 (b) An employing unit shall include in a contribution and employment report
18 information that the Secretary requires.

19 [(c) (1) An employing unit that fails to submit a contribution and employment
20 report under this section is subject to a penalty of \$35 unless the Secretary waives the
21 penalty for cause.

22 (2) An employing unit that submits a check or other negotiable instrument
23 in payment of any penalty under this subsection which is returned for insufficient funds is
24 subject to an additional penalty of \$25.]

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
26 October 1, 1996.
