- 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 10 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Health
- 13 and Mental Hygiene shall apply to the Secretary of Health and Human Services or the
- 14 Health Care Financing Administration for the Medicaid waivers necessaryto implement
- 15 the provisions of this Act. HOWEVER, THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL
- 16 HYGIENE MAY NOT IMPLEMENT THE MARYLAND PARTNERSHIP FOR LONG-TERM
- 17 CARE PROGRAM UNLESS SECTION 1917 OF TITLE XIX OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT
- 18 IS AMENDED TO EXEMPT FROM ITS ESTATE RECOVERY REQUIREMENTS THOSE
- 19 MEDICAID RECIPIENTS WHO ARE GRANTED A RESOURCES EXCLUSION UNDER THE
- 20 PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 July 1, 1996.
