- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 18 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS

- 20 (2) "LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" INCLUDES ANY INDIVIDUAL,
- 21 EXCEPT AN ELECTED OFFICIAL, WHO IS:
- 22 (I) A MEMBER OF A STATE, COUNTY, OR MUNICIPAL POLICE
- 23 FORCE;
- 24 (II) A MEMBER OF THE MASS TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION POLICE
- 25 FORCE, OR THE MARYLAND PORT ADMINISTRATION POLICE FORCE OF THE
- 26 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION OR THE MARYLAND TRANSPORTATION
- 27 AUTHORITY POLICE FORCE;
- 28 (III) A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND POLICE FORCE

3	(IV) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS APPOINTED OR GIVEN THE POWERS OF A SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED AND COMPENSATED BY THE STATE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF LAW AND THE MAINTENANCE OF ORDER ON PROPERTY OF THE STATE OR OF ANY OF ITS AGENCIES, OR FOR THE PROTECTION OF SUCH PROPERTY; A MEMBER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES SECURITY FORCE;

	(3) "FIRE AND RESCUE WORKER" INCLUDES THOSE INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED IN \S 9-503(A) OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE, WHETHER THE INDIVIDUAL IS PAID OR UNPAID.
19 20	(B) (1) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IS NOT AN OFFICER WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 35 OF THE MARYLAND DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.
21 22	(2) A FIRE OR RESCUE WORKER IS NOT AN OFFICER WITHIN THE MEANING OF ARTICLE 35 OF THE MARYLAND DECLARATION OF RIGHTS.
25	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the passage of this Act is contingent on the passage of Chapter (S.B/H.B)(6lr1040) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1996, a Constitutional Amendment, and its ratification by the voters of the State.
27 28	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to the provisions of Section 2 above this Act shall take effect December 1, 1996
