3 FOR the purpose of altering the earnings level above which a domestic servant in a
4 private home is a covered employee with respect to the household under workers'
5 compensation law.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Labor and Employment**

14 9-209.

15 An individual who is employed as a domestic servant in a private home is a covered
16 employee with respect to a household if the individual earns at least [\$250] \$1,000 in cash
17 in a calendar quarter from that household.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 1996.
