- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) The [commissioners] COUNTY COMMISSIONERS may change an adopted
- 18 budget only by resolutions that comply with this section, the Maryland Constitution, state
- 19 laws or public local laws. Changes may not be subdivided to alter the applicability of the
- 20 requirements of this section.
- 21 (b) The [commissioners] COUNTY COMMISSIONERS by resolution may establish
- 22 procedures for the administrative transfer of appropriations between general
- 23 classifications of expenditures in the current expense budget within the same office or
- 24 department, TRANSFERS BETWEEN DEPARTMENTS, AGENCIES, BOARDS, OR
- 25 COMMISSIONS, interproject transfers of appropriations between capital projects in the
- 26 capital budget, and the addition of new budget items. [However, only changes involving
- 27 less than \$5,000 each may be made under this subsection.
- 28 (c) Transfers or additions involving an amount of \$5,000 or more, ortransfers
- 29 between departments, agencies, boards, or commissions may be made only by resolution
- 30 approved by the commissioners.

- 1 (d)] (C) Any change involving funds totaling more than \$50,000 may be made 2 only by resolution approved by the commissioners after compliance with the publication 3 and hearing requirements applicable to the original proposed budget.
- 4 [(e)] (D) To meet a public emergency affecting life, health, or property, the 5 commissioners by resolution may make emergency appropriations from contingent or 6 surplus funds.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 July 1, 1996.
