4 5 6 7	FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners, by regulation, to restrict the hours and days for sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in the City; and generally relating to alcoholic beveragesin Baltimore City.
8 9 10 11 12	BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages Section 11-301, 11-302, 11-303, and 11-305 Annotated Code of Maryland (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)
13 14	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
15	Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

	(a) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Abeer license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on every day except Sunday.
20	(2) In Montgomery County the hours shall be as provided in § 11-516(d)(1).
	(3) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day following, except on Sunday when no sales shallbe permitted after 2 o'clock a.m.

19 20	(d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Dbeer and light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

29 30 31	(b) (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day, a person may not consume any alcoholic beverages on any premises open to the general public, any place of public accommodation, or any place at which setups or other component parts of mixed alcoholic drinks are sold, whether or not the premises or place is licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages or has any other license if any form of entertainment, live or recorded, is offered at the place or on the premises.
33	(2) (I) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY.
	(II) BY REGULATION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR.
37	(c) The owner, operator, or manager of the premises or place may notknowingly

38 permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages that is prohibited by this section.

1	(d) The owner, operator, or manager of any premises open to the general public
2	or of any place of public accommodation where any form of entertainmentis provided
3	between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day and where alcoholic beverages are consumed at any
4	hour of the day shall:
5	(1) Register with the fire department and the Department of Housing and
6	Community Development; and
7	(2) Comply with all federal, State, and city building, fire, health, and zoning
8	laws.
9	(e) Any person who consumes any alcoholic beverages on any premises
10	enumerated in this section and any owner, operator, or manager of thosepremises or

- 11 place who knowingly permits the consumption prohibited by this section is guilty of a
 12 misdemeanor and may be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for notmore than 3
 13 years or both.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 15 June 1, 1996.
