16 (c) (1) IN THIS SECTION, "STRUCTURED SETTLEMENT" MEANS A PLAN FOR
17 THE PAYMENT OF A JUDGMENT TO A PLAINTIFF FOR DAMAGES IN PERIODIC
18 INSTALLMENTS.

19 (2) Unless a contract with a private insurer provides otherwise, the

- 20 Treasurer or designee may compromise and settle a claim for money damages after the
