3 FOR the purpose of making it a misdemeanor subject to certain penalties for a

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article - Family Law

16 4-509.

17 (a) A person who fails to comply with the relief granted in an ex parte order

18 under § 4-505(a)(2)(i), (ii), (iii), (iv), or (v) of this subtitle or in a protective order under

19 § 4-506(d)(1), (2), (3), (4), or (5) of this subtitle OR A RESPONDENT WHO WILLFULLY

20 FAILS TO COMPLETE COUNSELING OR A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM ORDERED

21 UNDER § 4-506(D)(10) OF THIS SUBTITLE is guilty of a misdemeanor and onconviction is

22 subject, for each offense, to a fine not exceeding \$500 or imprisonmentnot exceeding 90

23 days or both.

24 (b) An officer shall arrest with or without a warrant and take into custody a

25 person whom the officer has probable cause to believe is in violation of an ex parte order

26 or protective order in effect at the time of the violation.
