A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Football Stadium at Camden Yards - Permanent Seat Licenses

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting any person, other than the Maryland Stadium Authority,

- 4 from marketing, offering for sale, or selling permanent seat licenses for seats at a
- 5 professional football stadium at Camden Yards in Baltimore City; requiring the
- 6 Authority to use any proceeds derived from the sale of certain permanent seat
- 7 licenses for certain purposes and to transfer certain remaining proceeds to the
- 8 General Fund of the State; defining a certain term; providing for the effective date
- 9 of this Act; and generally relating to a certain football stadium atCamden Yards in
- 10 Baltimore City.

21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

23 Article - Financial Institutions

- 25 (b) "Authority" means the Maryland Stadium Authority.
- 26 13-719.1.

27 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "STADIUM" MEANS A PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL28 STADIUM CONSTRUCTED AT CAMDEN YARDS IN BALTIMORE CITY.

(B) NO PERSON OTHER THAN THE AUTHORITY MAY MARKET, OFFER FOR
SALE, OR SELL A PERMANENT SEAT LICENSE FOR A SEAT AT ANY PROFESSIONAL
FOOTBALL STADIUM CONSTRUCTED AT CAMDEN YARDS IN BALTIMORE CITY.
(C) THE AUTHORITY SHALL:

5 (1) USE PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE SALE OF PERMANENT SEAT6 LICENSES AT THE STADIUM:

7 (I) TO PAY THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE STADIUM; AND

8 (II) TO RETIRE ANY BONDS ISSUED BY THE AUTHORITY FOR9 CONSTRUCTION OF THE STADIUM; AND

(2) AFTER THE CONDITIONS SPECIFIED IN ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION
HAVE BEEN MET, TRANSFER ANY REMAINING PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF
PERMANENT SEAT LICENSES AT THE STADIUM TO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE
STATE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJune 1, 1996.
