A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Procurement - Small Procurement Process - Threshold**

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the threshold governing small procurementsto increase  
4 the value of certain State procurement contracts in which a less formal process may  
5 be employed.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - State Finance and Procurement  
8 Section 13-109  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

14 13-109.

15 (a) In this section, "small procurement" means a procurement for which:

16 (1) a unit spends [~~\$10,000~~] \$25,000 or less; or

17 (2) a contractor provides services subject to § 11-202(3) of this article for  
18 expected annual revenues of [~~\$10,000~~] \$25,000 or less.

19 (b) A unit may make small procurements in accordance with the regulations of  
20 primary procurement units.

21 (c) A primary procurement unit may not create a small procurement byartificial  
22 division of a procurement.

23 (d) Any regulation of a primary procurement unit to govern small procurements:

24 (1) shall provide for a simplified administrative procedure;

25 (2) shall be consistent with the basic intent of this Division II; and

26 (3) may not be disadvantageous economically to the State.

1 (e) At least every 3 years, the Board shall:

2 (1) review the prevailing costs of labor and materials; and

3 (2) if warranted by changes in cost, recommend to the General Assembly  
4 appropriate adjustments in the ceiling for a small procurement.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
6 October 1, 1996.
