A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **University of Maryland System - Procurement Authority**

3 FOR the purpose of expanding the procurement authority of the University of Maryland
4 System to include certain supplies funded by proceeds from State general obligation
5 bonds.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
7 Article - State Finance and Procurement
8 Section 12-107(b)(5)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Finance and Procurement**

14 12-107.

15 (b) Subject to the authority of the Board, jurisdiction over procurement is as
16 follows:

17 (5) the University of Maryland System, without the approval of any of the
18 other primary procurement units, may engage in the procurement of:

19 (i) supplies for the University, including motor vehicles and, to the
20 extent provided by Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, information processing supplies, but
21 excluding[:

22 1. supplies funded by the proceeds from State general
23 obligation bonds; and

24 2.] insurance;

25 (ii) services for the University, including information processing
26 services to the extent provided in Title 3, Subtitle 4 of this article, but excluding banking
27 and financial services under the authority of the State Treasurer under item (1) of this
28 section;

1 (iii) construction and construction related services for the University,
2 regardless of the source of funds, to the extent that the Board grants authority over
3 specific projects or classes of projects; and

4 (iv) leases of real property for the University if the lease payments are
5 not paid from the General Fund of the State;

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
7 July 1, 1996.
