15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

18 8-301.

19 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, this subtitle applies to all
20 employees, including classified, unclassified, full-time, part-time, permanent, temporary,
21 and contractual employees, of all units in the executive branch of State government.

22 (b) This subtitle does not apply to a unit with an independent personnel system.

23 8-306.

24 AN EMPLOYEE SUBJECT TO THIS SUBTITLE IS ENTITLED TO TWO BREAKS
25 DURING A NORMAL WORK DAY. EACH BREAK MAY NOT EXCEED 15 MINUTES.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 1996.
