## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Vehicle Laws - Uninsured Motorists - Recovery of Evidences of Registration

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to send an investigator
- 4 to the home or workplace of an owner of a motor vehicle to attempt to recover the
- 5 evidences of registration from the owner when the registration of the motor vehicle
- 6 is suspended because of termination or lapse of required security and the owner has
- 7 not returned the evidences of registration within a certain time after receiving
- 8 notice of the suspension from the Administration; making stylistic changes; and
- 9 generally relating to the recovery of the evidences of registration of motor vehicles
- 10 with terminated or lapsed security.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 23 Article - Transportation

- 25 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 26 (b) "Required security" means security in the form and providing forthe
- 27 minimum benefits required under this subtitle or any other provisions of the Maryland
- 28 Vehicle Law.
- 29 (c) "Lapse" and "termination" mean a lapse or termination of required security,
- 30 as defined in regulations adopted by the Administration.

- 2 (a) The Administration may not issue or transfer the registration of a motor
- 3 vehicle unless the owner or prospective owner of the vehicle furnishes evidence
- 4 satisfactory to the Administration that the required security is in effect.
- 5 (b) The owner of a motor vehicle that is required to be registered in this State
- 6 shall maintain the required security for the vehicle during the registration period.
- 7 17-106.
- 8 (a) If the required security for any vehicle terminates or otherwiselapses at any 9 time, the registration of that vehicle:
- 10 (1) Is suspended automatically as of the date of termination or lapse; and
- 11 (2) Remains suspended until:
- 12 (i) The required security is replaced and the vehicle owner submits
- 13 evidence of replaced security on a form as prescribed by the Administration and certified
- 14 by an insurer or agent; and
- 15 (ii) Any uninsured motorist penalty fee assessed is paid to the
- 16 Administration.
- 17 (b) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, eachinsurer or
- 18 other provider of required security immediately shall notify the Administration of those
- 19 terminations or other lapses that are final.
- 20 (2) Each insurer or other provider of required security for a vehicle
- 21 registered as a Class B (for hire) vehicle under Title 13 of this article shall notify the
- 22 Administration within 45 days of a termination or other lapse that is final and occurs
- 23 anytime after the required security is issued or provided.
- 24 (c) On receipt of a notice under subsection (b) of this section, the Administration
- 25 shall make a reasonable effort to notify the owner of the vehicle that his registration has
- 26 been suspended.
- 27 (d) (1) Within 48 hours after an owner is notified by the Administration of the
- 28 suspension of registration, the owner shall surrender all evidences of that registration to
- 29 the Administration.
- 30 (2) If the owner fails to surrender the evidences of registration within the
- 31 48-hour period, the Administration:
- 32 (i) Shall SEND AN INVESTIGATOR TO THE HOME OR WORKPLACE
- 33 OF THE OWNER TO attempt to recover from the owner the evidences of registration; and
- 34 (ii) May suspend [his] THE OWNER'S license to drive until [he] THE
- 35 OWNER returns to the Motor Vehicle Administration the evidences of registration.
- 36 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 37 October 1, 1996.
