A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Government - Attorney General - Legal Adviser of and Representation to the Board**  
3 **of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City**

4 FOR the purpose of repealing the authority of the Attorney General to serve as the legal  
5 adviser of and to provide representation to the Board of Supervisors of Elections of  
6 Baltimore City.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
8 Article - State Government  
9 Section 6-107(a)  
10 Annotated Code of Maryland  
11 (1995 Replacement Volume)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - State Government**

15 6-107.

16 (a) The Attorney General is the legal adviser of and shall represent and otherwise  
17 perform all of the legal work for:

18 (1) [the Board of Supervisors of Elections of Baltimore City;

19 (2)] the Board of Liquor Commissioners of Baltimore City; and

20 [(3)] (2) the Sheriff of Baltimore City.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
22 October 1, 1996.
