A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Election Law - Voting Systems - Ballots Not Voted

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that certain voting systems automatically accept and count

- 4 a ballot that a voter has intentionally left blank without having tobe reprogrammed,
- 5 reset, or adjusted by an election judge.

6 BY adding to

- 7 Article 33 Election Code
- 8 Section 16B-5
- 9 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 10 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article 33 - Election Code

14 16B-5.

15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A VOTING SYSTEM IN WHICH BALLOTS16 ARE ELECTRONICALLY TABULATED AT THE POLLING PLACE.

17 (B) A SYSTEM CERTIFIED BY THE STATE BOARD SHALL AUTOMATICALLY

18 ACCEPT AND COUNT A BALLOT THAT HAS NOT BEEN VOTED WITHOUT HAVING TO 19 BE REPROGRAMMED, RESET, OR ADJUSTED IN ANY WAY THAT DISCLOSES A

20 VOTER'S CHOICE TO INTENTIONALLY LEAVE THE BALLOT BLANK.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 22 October 1, 1996.
