12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Labor and Employment**

16 (b) "Commissioner" means:

17 (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, the
18 Commissioner of Labor and Industry; AND

19 (2) IN §§ 5-213(A), 5-213(C), 5-213(D), 5-809, AND 5-810 OF THIS SUBTITLE,
20 THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY OR THE COMMISSIONER'S
21 AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 June 1, 1996.
