13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That Section(s) 324 and 325 and the subheading "Health - Workshops

15 and Factories"; and 326 through 333, inclusive, and the subheading "Health - Workshops

16 and Factories - Sweating Systems" of Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments of the

17 Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

19 October 1, 1996.
