2 **Real Property Assessments - Notice**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a supervisor of assessments for a county to provide written
4 notice to the owner of any real property if the property has decreased in its existing
5 value; and generally relating to real property assessments and notice requirements.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article - Tax - Property**

19 8-401.

20 (a) When any change as provided in subsection (b) of this section occurs in the
21 value or classification of any real property that a supervisor assesses, the supervisor shall
22 notify the owner or other appropriate person by a written notice of the proposed change.

23 (b) A written notice is required for:

24 (1) an increase OR DECREASE in an existing real property value;

25 (2) a change in the classification of the real property;

26 (3) establishment of an initial real property value;

27 (4) a decision on an assessment appeal or a petition to change an existing
28 real property value or classification; and

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1 (5) a revaluation or reclassification, if a valuation or classification has been
2 appealed but not finally determined.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
4 October 1, 1996.
