- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 Article - Tax - Property

19 8-401.

20 (a) When any change as provided in subsection (b) of this section occurs in the 21 value or classification of any real property that a supervisor assesses, the supervisor shall 22 notify the owner or other appropriate person by a written notice of the proposed change.

- 23 (b) A written notice is required for:
- 24 (1) an increase OR DECREASE in an existing real property value;
- 25 (2) a change in the classification of the real property;
- 26 (3) establishment of an initial real property value;

(4) a decision on an assessment appeal or a petition to change an existing28 real property value or classification; and

1 (5) a revaluation or reclassification, if a valuation or classification has been 2 appealed but not finally determined.

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect4 October 1, 1996.
