1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore City - Incinerator Installation - Authority to Prohibit**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing Baltimore City to prohibit the installation, alteration, or
4 extension of an incinerator in Baltimore City.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article - Environment**

18 9-201.

19 (e) "Refuse disposal system" includes:

- 20 (1) An incinerator;
- 21 (2) A transfer station;
- 22 (3) A landfill system;
- 23 (4) A landfill;
- 24 (5) A solid waste processing facility; and
- 25 (6) Any other solid waste acceptance facility.

2 (d) A person shall have a permit issued by the Secretary under this section before
3 the person installs, materially alters, or materially extends a water supply system,
4 sewerage system, or refuse disposal system.

5 (J) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, BALTIMORE CITY
6 MAY PROHIBIT THE INSTALLATION, ALTERATION, OR EXTENSION OF AN
7 INCINERATOR IN BALTIMORE CITY.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 October 1, 1996.
