1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Health Occupation Boards - Code of Conduct for Board Members**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that ~~the Attorney General or the Attorney General's~~
4 ~~designee~~ and the Executive Director of the State Ethics Commission or the
5 Executive Director's designee develop a proposed code of conduct for the members
6 of health occupation boards and their designated investigators; and report to certain
7 committees of the General Assembly before a certain date; and generally relating to
8 certain activities of members of health occupation boards.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
10 MARYLAND, That ~~the Attorney General or the Attorney General's designee~~ and the
11 Executive Director of the State Ethics Commission or the Executive Director's designee,
12 in consultation with the health occupation boards, shall develop a proposed code of
13 conduct for board members and their designated investigators and shall report to the
14 House Environmental Matters Committee and the Senate Economic and Environmental
15 Affairs Committee on or before July 1, 1997, in accordance with § 2-1312 of the State
16 Government Article, with their proposed code of conduct.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 1996.
