20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE
4 REGISTERED OR OF A TYPE CAPABLE OF BEING REGISTERED IN THIS STATE AS A
5 CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY OF 3/4 TON
6 OR LESS, THE GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT OF WHICH DOES NOT EXCEED 7,000 POUNDS.

7 (B) (1) SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THIS SECTION

(2) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED AS TO ELIMINATE
 APPLICABLE CHILD SAFETY SEAT AND SEAT BELT REQUIREMENTS UNDER §§22-412.2
 AND 22-412.3 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(B) (C) AN INDIVIDUAL MAY NOT DRIVE A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE ON A
 HIGHWAY IN THE STATE WHILE A PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS IS
 RIDING IN AN UNENCLOSED BED OF THE VEHICLE.

22 (C) AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS MAY NOT RIDE IN AN
 23 UNENCLOSED BED OF A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WHILE THE VEHICLE IS DRIVEN
 24 ON A HIGHWAY IN THE STATE.

25 27-101.

(a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to violate any of the provisions of the
Maryland Vehicle Law unless the violation is declared to be a felony bythe Maryland
Vehicle Law or by any other law of this State.

(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a
misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is
subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
