2 **Deer Hunting - Sabot Loads**

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the use of sabot loads in the hunting ofdeer in certain

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Natural Resources

- 15 (a) (1) A person may not hunt deer in the State with any automatic firearm. In
- 16 this subsection, an automatic firearm means a firearm designed to fire, or which is
- 17 mechanically altered to fire, 2 or more shots with 1 continuous pressure on the trigger.
- 18 (2) A person may not use full metal-jacketed, incendiary, or tracer bullets in
- 19 hunting deer in the State. However, the use of metal-jacketed bullets designed to expand
- 20 on impact is not prohibited.
- 21 (3) A person may not hunt deer with any firearm that uses an ammunition
- 22 clip holding more than 8 cartridges or bullets. In this paragraph, "ammunition clip"
- 23 includes a cartridge or bullet holder called a banana clip.
- 24 (4) A PERSON MAY NOT HUNT DEER USING SABOT LOADS IN A COUNTY
- 25 OR AN AREA OF A COUNTY DESIGNATED BY REGULATION OF THE DEPARTMENT AS
- 26 A COUNTY OR AN AREA IN WHICH THE USE OF A RIFLE OR HANDGUN IN THE
- 27 HUNTING OF DEER IS PROHIBITED.
- 28 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 29 October 1, 1996.
