A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 **Baltimore City - Alcoholic Beverages**
- (Local Hours and Days for Sale) 3

4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Baltimore City Board of License Commissioners, by

- 5 regulation, to restrict the hours and days for the sale and consumption of alcoholic
- beverages in a certain area of the City; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages 6
- 7 in Baltimore City.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
- 10 Section 11-301, 11-302, 11-303, and 11-305
- 11 Annotated Code of Maryland
- (1994 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement) 12

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

16 11-301.

(a) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Abeer 17 18 license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on every day 19 except Sunday.

20 (2) In Montgomery County the hours shall be as provided in § 11-516(d)(1).

(3) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2 21 22 o'clock a.m. on the day following, except on Sunday when no sales shallbe permitted after 23 2 o'clock a.m.

24 (4) In Frederick County, on Sunday the hours of operation may be from 1 25 o'clock p.m. to 12 midnight.

(5) In Washington County, the hours of sale are as provided under § 11-522 26 27 of this article.

28 (b) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Bbeer 29 license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

(2) In Montgomery County the privilege may be exercised from 9 o'clock 2 a.m. on any day to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day following for on-sale.

3 (3) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2 4 o'clock a.m. on the day following.

5 (c) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Cbeer 6 license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

7 (2) In Montgomery County, there shall be no sale before 11 o'clock a.m.

8 (3) In Caroline County, alcoholic beverages may be sold under the license 9 from 6 o'clock a.m. until 2 o'clock a.m. the following day.

10 (4) In Prince George's County, the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 11 o'clock a.m. on the day following.

(d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Dbeer 12 13 license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight.

14 (2) In Caroline County the hours shall be from 6 a.m. Monday through 15 Saturday until 1 a.m. the following day (including Sunday).

(3) In Kent County the hours of sale are as provided under § 11-515 of this 16 17 article.

(4) In Montgomery County the hours shall be from 9 o'clock a.m.on any day 18 19 to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day following for on-sale.

(5) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2 20 21 o'clock a.m. on the day following.

22 (e) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class H beer license may 23 be exercised shall be from 9 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, except in Montgomery 24 County the privilege may be exercised from 9 o'clock a.m. to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day 25 following.

26 (f) In Wicomico County, the hours for exercising on a Sunday the privileges 27 conferred by a seven day, Class A (off-sale) beer license shall be the same as for the other 28 days of the week.

(G) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY ON THE INNER 29 30 PARAMETER OF A RECTANGLE BOUNDED BY 31ST STREET ON THE SOUTH, 31 GREENMOUNT AVENUE ON THE EAST, 32ND STREET ON THE NORTH, AND BARCLAY 32 STREET ON THE WEST.

(2) BY REGULATION. THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY 33 34 RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER.

35 11-302.

(a) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Abeer and 36 37 light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on 38 every day except Sunday.

1 (2) In Montgomery County the hours shall be as provided in 11-516(d)(1). (3) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2 2 3 o'clock a.m. on the day following except on Sunday when no sales shall be permitted after 4 2 o'clock a.m. 5 (4) In Frederick County, on Sunday the hours of operation may be from 1 6 p.m. to 12 midnight. 7 (b) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Bbeer and 8 light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight. 9 (2) In Baltimore City, in Prince George's County and in Baltimore County 10 the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day following. 11 (3) In Montgomery County, except as provided in § 11-516 of this article, 12 the privilege may be exercised from 9 o'clock a.m. on any day to 1 a.m.on the day 13 following for on-sale. (c) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Cbeer and 14 15 light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight. (2) In Baltimore City, in Prince George's County, and in Baltimore County, 16 17 the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day following. 18 (3) In Montgomery County, except as provided in § 11-516 of this article, 19 there shall be no sale before 11 o'clock a.m. (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Dbeer and 20 21 light wine license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight. 22 (2) In Baltimore City the hours shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to1 o'clock a.m. 23 on the day following. (3) In Baltimore County the hours shall be from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. Monday 24 25 through Sunday. 26 (4) In Montgomery County, except as provided in § 11-516 of this article,

(4) in Montgomery County, except as provided in § 11-516 of this article,
the privilege may be exercised from 9 o'clock a.m. on any day to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day
following for on-sale.

(5) In Prince George's County the hours shall be from 6 o'clocka.m. to 2o'clock a.m. on the day following.

(6) In Wicomico County, notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph (1) of
this subsection, the privilege may be exercised on Sunday from 12 noon to 12 midnight
only by bowling alleys as defined in § 1-102(b)(3) of this article.

(e) Except in Caroline and Montgomery Counties, the hours during which the
privileges conferred by a Class H beer and light wine license may be exercised shall be
from 9 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight. In Caroline County the hours during which the
privileges conferred by a Class H beer and light wine license may be exercised shall be
from 6:00 o'clock a.m. to 2:00 o'clock a.m. the following day, and in Montgomery County

the privilege may be exercised from 9 o'clock a.m. on any day to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day
 following.

3 (f) In Wicomico County, the hours for exercising on a Sunday the privileges
4 conferred by a seven day, Class A (off-sale) beer and light wine license shall be the same
5 as for the other days of the week.

6 (g) In Kent County, the hours for exercising the privileges conferred by a seven 7 day, Class A (off-sale) beer and light wine license are as provided under § 11-515 of this 8 article.

9 (H) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY ON THE INNER
10 PARAMETER OF A RECTANGLE BOUNDED BY 31ST STREET ON THE SOUTH,
11 GREENMOUNT AVENUE ON THE EAST, 32ND STREET ON THE NORTH, AND BARCLAY
12 STREET ON THE WEST.

(2) BY REGULATION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY
RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER AND
LIGHT WINE.

16 11-303.

(a) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Abeer, wine
and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 12 o'clock midnight, on
every day except Sunday.

20 (2) The provisions of paragraph (1) are superseded as follows:

21 (i) In Annapolis the hours may be fixed by the Mayor, Counselor and22 Aldermen of the City of Annapolis;

23 (ii) In Talbot County the hours shall be from 8 o'clock a.m. to 1224 o'clock midnight;

(iii) In St. Mary's County holders of a Class A-1 license shall beentitled to sell on Sunday;

(iv) In Frederick County holders of a Class A beer, wine and liquor
(off-sale) license may sell beer, wine and liquor for off-premises consumption on
Sundays from 1 p.m. to 12 o'clock midnight if they hold a special Sunday opening permit;
and

31 (v) In Kent County the provisions of § 11-515 apply.

32 (b) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Bbeer, wine 33 and liquor license may be exercised are from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. on the day 34 following.

(2) In Annapolis the hours shall be as fixed by the Mayor, Counselor andAldermen of the City of Annapolis.

37 (3) In Montgomery County, except as provided in § 11-516 of this article,38 the hours are from 9 o'clock a.m. on any day to 1 o'clock a.m. on the day following.

1 (4) In the 47th alcoholic beverages district in Baltimore City, the hours for 2 off-sales under a Class B beer, wine and liquor license for use in a restaurant are as 3 provided for in § 6-201(d) of this article.

4 (c) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Cbeer, wine 5 and liquor license may be exercised shall be from 6 o'clock a.m. to 2 o'clock a.m. the day 6 following.

7 (2) In Annapolis, the hours shall be as fixed by the Mayor, Counselor and8 Aldermen of Annapolis.

9 (3) In Kent County the hours of sale are as provided under § 11-515 of this 10 article.

(4) In Montgomery County, the hours of sale are as provided in § 11-516 of12 this article.

13 (d) (1) The hours during which the privileges conferred by a Class Dbeer, wine14 and liquor license may be exercised are from 6 a.m. to 12 midnight.

15 (2) In Baltimore City the hours are from 6 a.m. to 1 a.m.

16 (3) In Caroline County the hours are from 6 a.m. Monday throughSaturday17 until 1 a.m. the following day (including Sunday).

18 (4) In Baltimore County the hours are from 6 a.m. to 2 a.m.

(5) In Queen Anne's County the hours on Monday through Saturdayarefrom 6 a.m. to 2 a.m. the following day.

21 (6) In Wicomico County the hours are from 10 a.m. to 2 a.m., Monday

22 through Saturday. Where sales are permitted until 2 a.m., alcoholic beverages may not be 23 consumed after 2:30 a.m., at which time all tables and bar areas shall be cleared of all

24 alcoholic beverages.

(E) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY ON THE INNER
PARAMETER OF A RECTANGLE BOUNDED BY 31ST STREET ON THE SOUTH,
GREENMOUNT AVENUE ON THE EAST, 32ND STREET ON THE NORTH, AND BARCLAY

(2) BY REGULATION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY
RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF BEER, WINE
AND LIQUOR.

32 11-305.

33 (a) This section applies only in Baltimore City.

(b) (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day, a person may not consume any alcoholic beverages on any premises open to the general public, any place of public accommodation, or any place at which setups or other component parts of mixed alcoholic drinks are sold, whether or not the premises or place is licensed for the sale of alcoholic beverages or has any other license if any form of entertainment, live or recorded, is offered at the place or on the premises.

(2) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE CITY ON THE
 INNER PARAMETER OF A RECTANGLE BOUNDED BY 31ST STREET ON THE SOUTH,
 GREENMOUNT AVENUE ON THE EAST, 32ND STREET ON THE NORTH, AND BARCLAY
 STREET ON THE WEST.

5 (II) BY REGULATION, THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS
6 MAY RESTRICT THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC
7 BEVERAGES.

8 (c) The owner, operator, or manager of the premises or place may notknowingly9 permit the consumption of alcoholic beverages that is prohibited by this section.

10 (d) The owner, operator, or manager of any premises open to the general public 11 or of any place of public accommodation where any form of entertainmentis provided 12 between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. on any day and where alcoholic beverages are consumed at any 13 hour of the day shall:

14 (1) Register with the fire department and the Department of Housing and15 Community Development; and

16 (2) Comply with all federal, State, and city building, fire, health, and zoning17 laws.

(e) Any person who consumes any alcoholic beverages on any premises
enumerated in this section and any owner, operator, or manager of thosepremises or
place who knowingly permits the consumption prohibited by this section is guilty of a
misdemeanor and may be fined not more than \$5,000 or imprisoned for notmore than 3
years or both.

23 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect24 June 1, 1996.
