- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Washington County the advertisement for bids on
- 4 certain contracts by publication in certain newspapers or through electronic media.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 6 The Public Local Laws of Washington County
- 7 Section 1-106(a) and 7-204(d)(2)
- 8 Article 22 Public Local Laws of Maryland
- 9 (1991 Edition and August 1994 Supplement, as amended)
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 Article 22 - Washington County

- 14 (a) The County Commissioners or any employee of the county may not enter into
- 15 any contract of sale or purchase or any contract for any county work, project, or other
- 16 expenditure to which the county is a party where the amount involved in the contract
- 17 exceeds \$15,000 without advertising for bids [in 1 or more newspapers published in the
- 18 county. The publication of that advertisement shall appear at least once a week prior to
- 19 the date on which bids are to be filed.] AT LEAST 1 WEEK BEFORE THE BIDBY
- 20 PUBLICATION IN AT LEAST ONE NEWSPAPER THAT IS PUBLISHED IN THE COUNTY OR
- 21 THROUGH ELECTRONIC MEDIA.

- 2 (d) (2) Bids for the work shall be prepared by the Road Engineer andshall be
- 3 invited by publication at least once a week for 2 successive weeks in such daily paper or
- 4 papers the County Commissioners designate OR BY ADVERTISEMENT THROUGH
- 5 ELECTRONIC MEDIA. The County Commissioners do not have to have any workdone by
- 6 contract if, after bids have been received and opened, it is found thatthe same work can
- 7 be done at less expense by direct employment of the required labor or if an emergency
- 8 exists of such nature as to require the speedy repair or replacement of a county road,
- 9 street, alley, highway, or bridge or other construction in connection with it. This
- 10 subsection does not require bids when the work is to be done by the County Roads
- 11 Department.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 1996.
