A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County - Election Judges - Salaries**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salaries of the judges of elections in Washington County;  
4 and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of  
5 incumbent election judges in Washington County.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article 33 - Election Code  
8 Section 2-7(f)(6)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1993 Replacement Volume and 1995 Supplement)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article 33 - Election Code**

14 2-7.

15 (f) (6) (i) In Washington County, chief judges shall be paid [\$75] \$100 per  
16 day for each election day, plus a mileage allowance as determined by the board; judges  
17 shall be paid [\$65] \$80 per day for each election day.

18 (ii) In Washington County, after a chief judge or judge has received a  
19 course of instruction in poll working he shall be eligible for additional compensation if  
20 approved by the board and provided in the county budget.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,  
22 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or  
23 apply to the salary or compensation of an election judge in Washington County in office  
24 on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or  
25 compensation of an election judge in Washington County shall take effect at the  
26 beginning of the next following term of office.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
28 October 1, 1996.
