FOR the purpose of expanding the list of eligible projects for wastewater treatment construction grants and loans to include projects providing for phosphorus removal.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 (a) Grants or loans may be awarded under this section to any State or local 15 governmental entity responsible by law for the provision of sewerage systems to finance 16 the construction of sewerage systems needed to improve water quality whether or not the 17 project is eligible for construction grant assistance under the FederalClean Water Act.
18 (b) Projects which may receive financial assistance under this section include 19 those providing for:
20 (1) Chlorine removal;
21 (2) Nitrogen removal; [or]
22 (3) PHOSPHORUS REMOVAL; OR

- 1 [(3)] (4) Wastewater collection or treatment otherwise undertaken to 2 correct existing special water quality needs or an extraordinary publichealth problem.
- 3 (c) Grants or loans awarded under this section may be awarded for upto 1004 percent of eligible costs.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 1996.
